- GSO (General Service Office) deals with New York records and employs 90 people. They receive & answer about 29,000 emails each year. They receive about 40,000 pieces of mail each year
- There is a pamphlet that provides information on recommended contributions to GSO, the district, and the area.
- Grapevine print subscriptions have declined by 50%, but alternatives like podcasts are gaining popularity.
- Grapevine is facing a \$1.1 million deficit due to decreasing subscriptions.
- There are discussions about the future of the print edition if the current trend continues.
- Expenses for GSO are around \$17.2 million for the year.
- It is still running a deficit of \$1.5 million.
- Fifth edition of the Big Book is in the works with new stories and a plain language version. It will be years before the new publishing is done.
- Jon, the delegate, was not concerned about proposed changes to the Big Book.
